Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to:

a) remove the right turn prohibition onto Kennedy Way that currently affects Heron Way, to permit all vehicles to carry out the manoeuvre;

b) bring forward unchanged into the new order the current prohibition of 'U' Turns that affects Kennedy Way; between Scott Way/Link Road roundabout and Heron Way; and

c) revoke the County Council of Avon (Heron Way and Kennedy Way, Chipping Sodbury, District of Northavon) (Prohibition of Right Turn) (Prohibition of 'U' Turn) Order 1994, as varied, in favour of the measures specified in item a) and item b) above.

(KENNEDY WAY, CHIPPING SODBURY) (PROHIBITION OF 'U' TURNS) ORDER 202(-)

The South Gloucestershire District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

- 1. This order shall come into operation on the and may be cited as the South Gloucestershire Council (Kennedy Way, Chipping Sodbury) (Prohibition of 'U' Turns) Order 202(-).
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes in an emergency, proceeding in either carriageway of that length of Kennedy Way which extends from, and including, its junction with Heron Way to the roundabout at the junction of Scott Way/Link Road to make a 'U' turn so as to proceed in the opposite carriageway of that length of road.
- 3. The County Council of Avon (Heron Way and Kennedy Way, Chipping Sodbury, District of Northavon) (Prohibition of Right Turn) (Prohibition of 'U' Turn) Order 1994 as varied by the South Gloucestershire Council (Various Roads, Almondsbury and Chipping Sodbury) (Prohibited Movements) (Variation) Order 2012 is hereby revoked.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Background

The existing Kennedy Way / Heron Way junction is a major/minor priority junction where vehicles on Heron Way give way to traffic on Kennedy Way. Kennedy Way is a single lane dual carriageway. Right turn movements from Heron Way onto Kennedy Way are currently restricted to buses, taxis, motorcycles, pedal cycles and authorised vehicles only.

Purpose of the scheme


The purpose of this revocation is to compliment the Heron Way signalisation scheme which will allow all vehicles to turn right out of Heron Way via signal control. This scheme was consulted on in July 2021.

Proposed scheme

The current restriction for right turning traffic on Heron Way will be removed to permit all vehicles to carry out the manoeuvre. The junction will be signalised with all movements signal controlled other than the left turn out of Heron Way, which will remain a give way. The existing TRO also includes a U-turn prohibition on Kennedy Way, between Heron Way and Scott Way; this part of the TRO will be brought forward unchanged into a new order.

Drawing reference

The existing TRO is shown on plans T438-709-016 & T438-709-017. The following roads are affected by this scheme: Kennedy Way, Heron Way.
