COVID-19 YTC Updates & Info

The current global pandemic has impacted us all and we want to start off by saying we hope that you, your family and friends are all staying well.

At the time of writing, our venues, play areas and outdoor gym are closed and several of our popular events have been cancelled or postponed. However, we are still working hard, with staff working from home and in regular contact with elected Councillors, and out estates team are undertaking essential maintenance works to upkeep our facilities that are open to the public.

Kingsgate Park

The Town Council reopened Kingsgate Park on Friday 24th April with **in line with Government guidelines**.

The park opening/closing times will be: 10.00am - 5.00pm but **the play area, gym** equipment, sports court, toilets and water feature will remain closed to the public.

Kickabout Areas

Kickabout areas at Halifax Road, Lye Field, Millside and Yate West Kickabout* are open with social distancing guidelines in place.

*The Yate West Kickabout area, near Tyndale Primary school, will be open every weekday from approx. 3.30pm (closed daily at 8am) and will be open all weekend.

Brinsham Lake

Angling is now permitted with social distancing and other guidelines in place. Notices will be displayed around the lake in respect of the guidelines - you can also view these guidelines on our website.

Sunnyside Tennis Courts

The Sunnyside tennis courts are now available for public use 7 days a week subject to the hirer complying with the safe distancing rules (with members of the same household or one other person staying two metres apart).

I am also very pleased we have raised the money towards YOSC as this money will mean users can get more games on the pitches and have far less wet weather postponements."
