THE RAILWAY HOTEL WAS OF GREAT SIGNIFICANCE IN THE HISTORY OF STATION ROAD. ONE OF THE FIRST BUILDINGS ERECTED AFTER THE ARRIVAL OF THE RAILWAY. IT BEGAN AS A HOTEL FOR VISITORS. LATER IT BECAME POPULAR WITH CATTLE & PRODUCE MARKET VISITORS.

RAILWAY BUILDINGS

OPENED IN JUNE 1844, THE RAILWAY WAS LARGELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE GROWTH OF YATE DURING THE 19TH CENTURY! YATE RAILWAY HISTORY HAS ITS ORIGINS IN A HORSE DRAWN TRAMWAY (DRAMWAY), RUNNING FROM COAL PITS NEAR WESTERLEIGH TO THE CITY OF BRISTOL.
