Yate Town Council is in the initial stages of talking to local people about the idea of putting a small community allotment in your area.

One of the most commonly requested facilities which local people ask us to provide as a Town Council are allotments for local people.

Allotments have been cited as a significant source of both physical activity and positive mental and social wellbeing.


We have the start of an idea how we might be able to do this and how it could work— and we are really hoping to hear your views and receive feedback about it before we decide if and how to go ahead.

We think that using a small section of the land at Rodford Field may work. It would only be small; most of the land would stay as it is currently - as open space for general use.

We know that the open space is well used and much loved, so we have no plans to change that or take that away from residents.

We are potentially considering using a small section - less than half of the area - as shown below, to make a few allotment plots; some would be half plot sized and others quarter plot sized.

The field is shown below and outlined in red, and the potential allotment plots are drawn onto the map.



First Steps

Yate Town Council is actively talking to Abbotswood Action Group about the idea at the moment.

We would also like to hear from you as a local resident if you have any thoughts you'd like to share about this idea.

We are also considering creating a small 'test plot' as a first step. This will help us to see if the idea could work and identify any problems at an early stage.
