

Yate Heritage Centre - How are we minimising risk?

Please stay at home if you or your close contacts have symptoms of COVID-19.

We ask that you help us to keep you safe by:

- All attendees 11yrs+ need to wear a face covering (unless exempt) covering over your nose and mouth at all times inside the building;
- Providing your contact details for "Test and Trace";
- Follow the rule of 6 when booking indoor services;
- Maintain social distancing always 1m+ and ensure children do too;
- Wash or sanitize your hands when you arrive, before using toilets, between activities and whenever advised by staff;
- Comply with our directions for movement around the building;
- Do not eat indoors and bring your own drink;
- Please take litter home with you.

We take the health and safety of you and your children very seriously and we have taken several measures today, to reduce the risk of COVID-19 contamination.

We have:

- Cleaned our premises thoroughly before and after every workshop;
- Worn PPE where appropriate;
- Washed and sanitized our hands regularly and provided visitors with facilities to do so;

- Ventilated the building;
- Kept all areas clean, tidy and free from litter;
- Signposted clear access routes including entrances and exits;
- Limited the number of people and staff indoors and in each area of the venue;
- Planned activities in a way that maintains social distancing;
- Ensured equipment is cleaned thoroughly and/or provided new equipment for each visitor;
- Staggered booking spaces and times.

If we feel that you are not complying with our Covid-19 policy, we will ask you to leave the Yate Heritage Centre.
